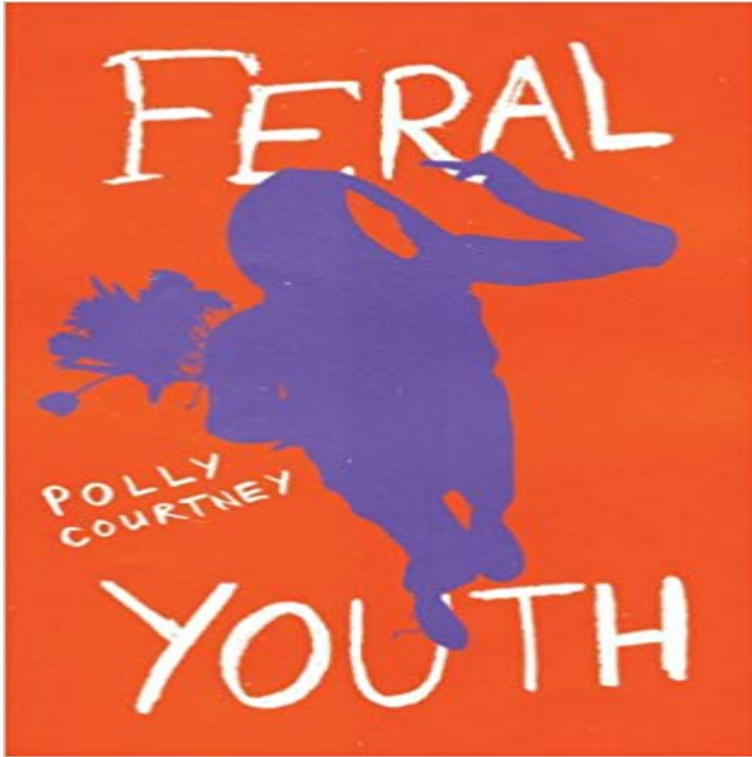


Feral Youth
