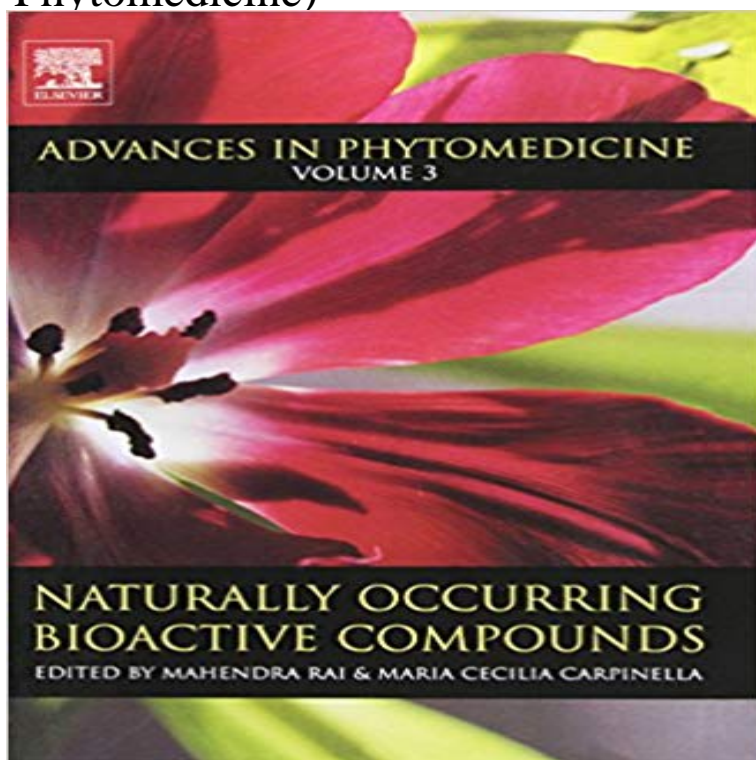


Naturally Occurring Bioactive Compounds, Volume 3 (Advances in Phytomedicine)
