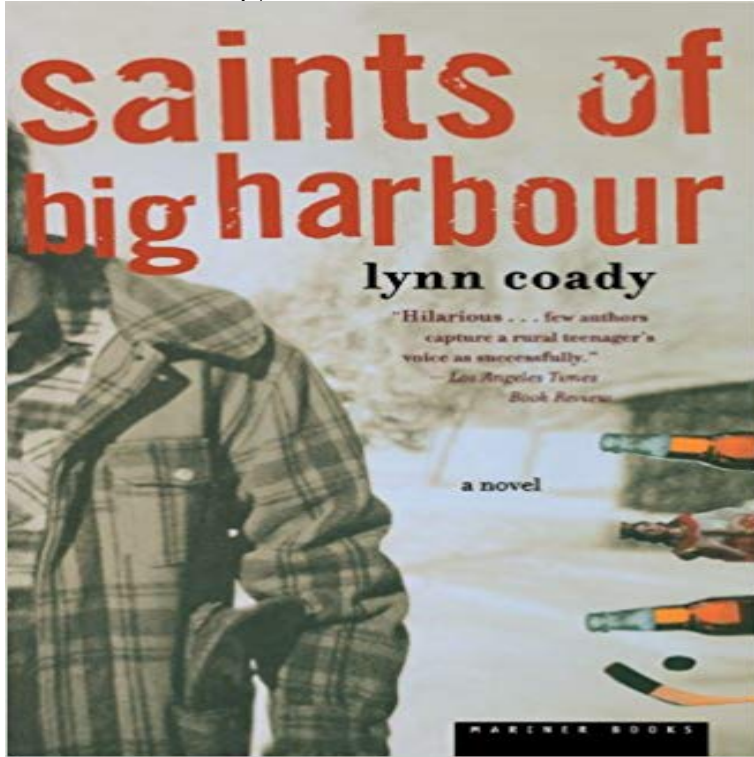


Saints of Big Harbour: A Novel
