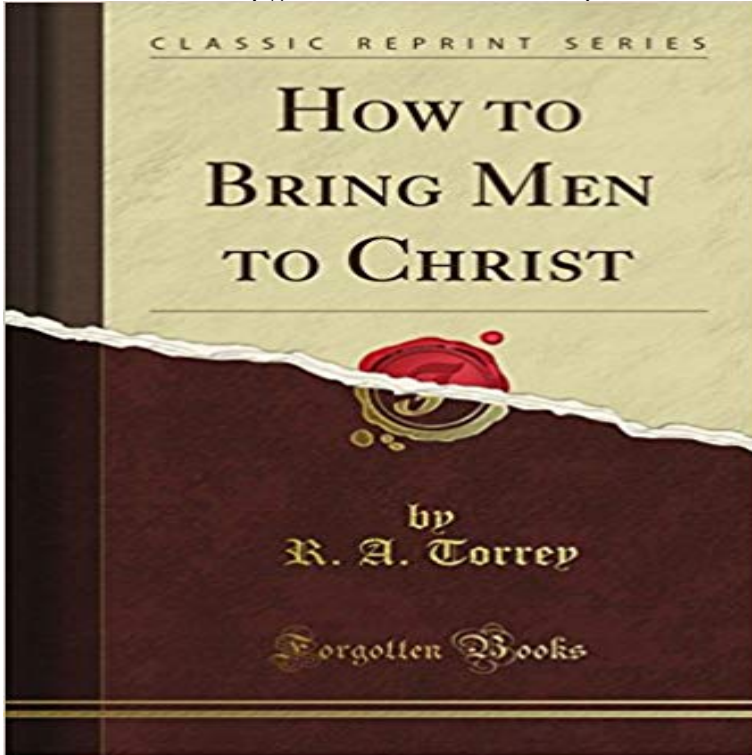


## How to Bring, Men to Christ (Classic Reprint)
